

Parent Focus Group Invitation

The Office of the Public Advocate, Bill de Blasio, and the Fund for Public Advocacy are collaborating with the NYC Department of Education (DOE) in a study of the Special Education Reform initiative. The initiative is intended to increase the number of students with disabilities educated with their non-disabled peers in their home-zoned school. The purpose of the study is to inform the DOE and the general public about the effectiveness of the initiative's implementation. The first report, *Educating All Students Well: Special Education Reform in New York City Public Schools*, was released in August 2012 (http://advocate.nyc.gov/special-ed).

You are invited to participate in a focus group for parents of students with disabilities in community public schools and district 75 public schools, scheduled for June 4th. Your participation is critical to help us learn more about schools' efforts to date to achieve the goals of the reform and inform potential mid-course corrections. **Your participation is voluntary, and your comments will be kept anonymous and confidential.**
